## COURT ORDER NO. 2021-058

## **ORDER RESCINDING BAN ON OUTDOOR BURNING**

**BE IT REMEMBERED** that on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2021, the DeWitt County Commissioners Court adopted Court Order No. 2021-055, an Order banning outdoor burning in the unincorporated areas of DeWitt County due to extant circumstances that warranted the imposition of a burn ban; and

WHEREAS, the conditions that warranted the adoption of Said Order have dissipated significantly or no longer exist in major sections of the County at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has conveyed express powers upon the county judge allowing for unilateral action on his part with respect to the lifting of the existing burn ban;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECREED, PROCLAIMED, AND PUBLISHED:

- 1. That the Keech Byram Drought Index has fallen below the threshold that allows for a ban on outdoor burning.
- 2. That the current ban on outdoor burning is no longer warranted.
- **3.** That Commissioner's Court Order No. 2021-055 is rescinded by this Order immediately upon execution.
